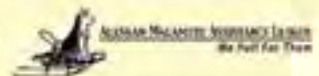

The 2014 Membership Renewal cycle is open, and runs through the end of March, as usual. The form is in the Dec-Mar Newsletters, and the form with the new electronic payment link is on the web site.

Please take extra care to update all your contact information, especially your email address. Your registered email will be your primary contact for all electronic balloting, starting with the first round of the National Specialty Judges Selection this summer. If you have any question about your email link to AMCA, send Leneia or me a post to confirm. If you have been receiving the email bulletins, you know we can reach you. The membership overwhelmingly approved moving to electronic balloting, but it will only work if we have reliable contact information for everyone.

Speaking of e-balloting, you will notice the new check-box at the bottom of the Membership Renewal. We will mail a paper ballot to every member who checks the box. If you do not check the box you will get the email ballot. All ballots to one household must be the same type; we cannot mix postal and electronic ballots to one address. This check-box will only be on the Renewal this year. Your preference will be recorded, but you can change it with Leneia any time.

Our goal is a secure-but-simple system that anyone can use. All the election information will be published well in advance. When

the election opens, each member will get an email notice with a personal ID and a direct link to a unique ballot. Clicking the link logs you in to your ballot. Click the boxes next to your choices, click "submit", and you're done. Voting will stay open for at least 30 days to allow for the return of all postal ballots. All votes will be tabulated and reported electronically.

The transition to e-balloting is bound to have some challenges, but we will make sure everyone has the opportunity to vote, and every vote is counted. If you have any questions or suggestions let me know.

2013 December's Delegate Report

The December Delegate Meeting was in conjunction with the Eukanuba all breed dog show's in Orlando Florida. The weather was great, the dog show entry was excellent, with entries represented from around world. The dog show was in a new facility this year which housed all of the breeds, as well as obedience and agility. The Alaskan Malamute had a great representation of our breed with dogs from around the world. Congratulations to all the winners.

Thursday and Friday were delegate meetings. Saturday and Sunday was the Eukanuba dog show. AKC asked all the delegates to help out with the dog show, and I was able to be a ring steward.

George Levelle drove down from a Wisconsin with two dogs to host the Alaskan malamute breed booth. With George's two dogs and help from some of the Alaskan Malamute exhibitors, a great job was done educating the public on whether they should own our breed. George had a laptop with a presentation of what Alaskan malamutes can go through as they grow. Pictures on the laptop consisted of long coats, muddy puppies and dogs blowing coat, George did an excellent job hosting the Alaskan Malamute Breed Booth,

AKC reduced the fee for Juniors transferring on to papers and off papers, and to put a Junior's name on a dog or remove a Junior's name from the dog will now cost that Junior ten dollars. Also AKC is considering having a Reserve Best Junior. Awarding Reserve Best Junior would be optional for the club.

Following are some of the Topics Discussed at the Delegate meeting:

From Mr. Ljungren: Good morning. The Canine Good Citizen program started in 1989. It has grown now to a comprehensive three-level program consisting of AKC STAR Puppy; the CGC test, which is now a titling activity and the recently introduced Community Canine test, which can be thought of as the advanced CGC, which carries the title CGCA. We heard from many of the Board candidates this morning

about ways that AKC can reach out to the general dog-loving public. This program is one of the ways we can do it. And it is a program that we have had for 25 years. It has certainly been a successful program, but I think it can become a giant program. The giant has started to stir in the last couple of years, with some fresh thinking and a little more energy.

There was an article in AKC Family Dog entitled Community Canine, the Good Manners Master's Degree. And there was an article in Dog News. The Community Canine test has been very well received. I would like to share with you the beginning of the Dog News article. It says: "It seems there is always a fun new event in which members of the dog owning public may participate, thanks to AKC. In addition to being a great way for owners to spend time with their dogs, the substantive training that these events require also enriches the other aspects of living with our four-legged friends. For example, the AKC recently developed guidelines for earning its latest title, the AKC Community Canine title."

The Sports Department views the CGC family of activities as a logical beginning step into additional AKC activities. This is Dorice and her Soft Coated Wheaten Terrier named Krista. Krista is the first dog to earn the CGCA title. Dorice is a CGC evaluator. The following are Dorice's comments from the Dog News article. She said: "The CGC program should be part of the training that every family dog receives. Its goals are attainable; the sequence is logically based on age and appropriate behavior. It builds dog and handler confidence, and the bond that they share. STAR Puppy, CGC and CGCA are one of the best ways to introduce new owners to all they can do with their dogs, and attract new participants to AKC events. Many dog owners are so motivated after passing the STAR Puppy or CGC test, that they take an additional obedience, rally or agility class with the hope of competing." The CGC program provides an opportunity to reach many new dog owners that otherwise would never connect with AKC. Once this connection has been made, information will be provided to these owners that can potentially result in more participation in AKC events, and more association with AKC clubs. In order to tell you more about the CGC family of activities, I would like to introduce the individual that is largely responsible for the success of the CGC program through her insightful and skillful leadership - Dr. Mary Burch, Director

of the Canine Good Citizen program.

From Dr. Burch: Good morning. I'm here today to talk about my favorite topic in the world—the American Kennel Club's Canine Good Citizen program.

My story began as many stories do, which is Once Upon a Time. Once upon a time, before the internet, before I knew about the American Kennel Club, before I knew about the benefits of training your dog, and before I knew about responsible breeders, when a beloved Siberian Husky died, we decided to get another dog.

My husband ultimately became what we call a dog person, but at that time, he knew so little about the breed he saw on television that he thought I should have, he had to write the name of the breed on a piece of paper. He said we were going on Saturday, and we were going to get a Bor-DERR Collie.

I don't have to tell this audience about the breed characteristics of Border Collies...if they don't have jobs, they can be maniacs, and so on. BEHOLD...the Border Collie. But that's not what I got. Here's what I got.

This is a purebred Border Collie. Four months old, never been in a house, never been in a car, had every parasite known to man. Full of fears and phobias, this little dog had too many behavior problems to list. I'd never seen anything like it.

I called a trainer who came and looked at my puppy. He said, "you've made one mistake by getting this dog, don't make a second one by keeping him." The trainer offered to go with me to do the very difficult thing that he thought should be done and then he said he'd help me find another dog. The problem was, I'd already looked into this puppy's eyes and said, "You're my dog now," and he wasn't going anywhere.

I called a second trainer who said he could indeed fix my dog, but this would need to be a Board and Train arrangement. He would keep my dog for six weeks and I wasn't permitted to watch the sessions. Now, I didn't know what he was going to do, but I had a hunch it wasn't going to involve a lot of cookies and kind words.

I called a third trainer. As luck would have it, for me, the third time was the charm. I ended up in the hands of an American Kennel Club obedience trainer. I took private

lessons and group classes. I socialized my dog. And within about two years, Laddie had the AKC's Utility Dog title American Kennel Club Obedience training saved my dog's life, and I believe in what we are doing in our clubs and our training classes all the way down to the bottom of my guts. You know, there are a lot of dogs and dog owners out there like me and Laddie, and for them, we now have the Canine Good Citizen program that provides a wonderful starting point in training.

Canine Good Citizen started in 1989. Since then, more than 600,000 dogs have passed the CGC test. Canine Good Citizen classes provide in-person training using evidence-based procedures that we know work. Canine Good Citizen has been become and will remain the gold standard of behavior for dogs in our communities. In January 2013, we gave dog owners an option. They could have a CGC as a certificate only, or CGC as

an official title. We are not quite at the one-year mark, and we already have more than 15,000 dog owners who chose the CGC official title option. For 20 percent of those titles, the dog owners had had no previous connection with the American Kennel Club. So that means these dog owners registered or listed their dogs with AKC by getting an AKC, PAL or Canine Partners in order to get the title.

The Trailer Task Force Project. The first trailer went out in the first 30 days of the program. In 90 days 66 clubs are participating in the program with donations of 200 thousand dollars.

From Ms. Laurans: Six trailers have either been completed or are close to being completed. This is wonderful. You guys have done a great job. We hope that you and your clubs will continue to support the mission that helps to provide pet disaster

trailers for areas that really need them. We would like to thank AKC Reunite for their commitment of \$250,000 in matching funds and their wonderful Staff. Dallas [Harsa] and Tom [Sharp] have been just unbelievable. Most of all, we want to thank you; we want to thank your clubs. Your support of this project will save the lives of people and their dogs. This project will help the general public know that AKC and its clubs and the clubs' members really care about dogs. Thank you so very much.

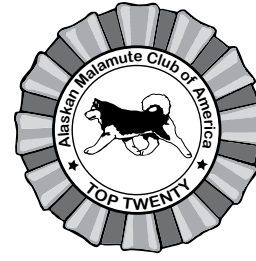

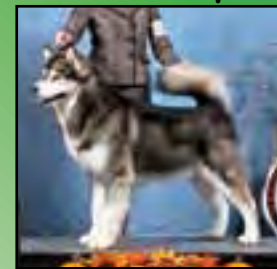
