### *Correction to John Podolak's article about using a properly fitting weight pull harness.*

Page 38 April newsletter

Thank you Michelle for letting us know that the pictures in this article were reversed.

If you reverse the new and old pictures in the article, you can see that the new harness is flat around the neck - you can see the flat webbing with the fleece on the edges and the neck of old harness is wrapped with padding and tape into a round shape.

Rounded harnesses aren't a problem if they fit correctly but the one Ziggy is wearing is too big. You can see a dark line coming straight up Ziggy's leg to his shoulder. The old harness is much closer to that 'line' than the new one because it's too big. It slides back behind his withers and the front of the neck slides up and begins to choke him at higher weights.

# Committee Reports & Special Reports

## AKC Gazette

It's been an exhilarating time, as I become familiar with the AKC Gazette style guide, and the detailed process of selecting topics, developing story ideas, and coordinating deadline schedules for my columns.

Most of all, I am so thrilled to be working with the Gazette's Senior Editor, Arliss Paddock. She is a consummate professional: a top editor and a deeply experienced dog fancier, and it is a joy to communicate with her, as our visions for the Gazette are clearly aligned.

Thinking about the Gazette takes me back so many years, as I first subscribed when I began showing in AKC obedience trials in 1969: fifty years ago. Of course, it was a print magazine back then, all in black and white, perhaps just a half-inch thick: able to contain all of the editorial material plus the upcoming show schedule, and the show results and new titles in one compact publication!

In the decades to come, the Gazette blossomed, first adding color to the cover and then full-color to the inside pages, and the separate Awards publication was created to cover all the results of AKC all-breed shows, obedience trials, and all the AKC's performance events such as Agility, Tracking, Lure Coursing, and Field Trials, plus of course the reports of new titles earned across all forms of competition.

Most recently, of course, the Gazette was transitioned into an online-only publication. I will not deny that I deeply miss the Gazette in print – a tangible, beautiful publication which won top awards year after year. I'm sure that many others feel as I do, but now it carries on in electronic, searchable form we can read on all of our devices, anywhere and anytime.

In its present form, the Working Breed columns are featured four times per year: in January, April, July, and October. I'm presently working on my July column, which will feature

the journey of a lovely Malamute, now called Raven, from starvation and extreme neglect and confinement to a fully-rehabilitated, normal, loving, stable and beautiful companion.

## The AAAM Committee is offering a new award!

It has come to our committee's attention there are a lot more people out there having fun collecting "letters", both in front of the name and after their dog's name. These days there are more and more options for titles, especially since the AKC keeps adding certificates that can be earned: trick dog, multi levels of CGC, barn hunt, dock diving etc.

This additional AAAM certificate is being offered because there are now so many new and exciting activities to title or certificate with Alaskan Malamutes – and- our members are doing them with their dogs. So, we are offering another option.

Like all other certificates the AAM Committee awards, this can be applied for posthumously. You do not need to be an AMCA member. And you do not have to live in the USA.

Our committee would love to see your packets/applications for this new option. The new title will not be awarded until 2020, with the first certificates being awarded at the 2020 National. But you can start putting your packets/applications together and submit them to our committee following the 2019 National.

## BAM = Buddy Alaskan Malamute

Requirements:

#1 Temperament: the same as AAAM, SAM & VAM must include written verification of public interaction/community service. Pictures are a bonus.

#2 Any combination of 10 verifiable titles or certificates.

Must be issued by a >>national<< organization like the AKC, AMCA, CKC, UKC, etc.

Titles can be ATTS, CGC, Trick Dog, Dock Diving, championship, herding, scent work, tracking, WPD, WWPD, WTD etc.

No MORE than FIVE (5) in any one "activity/category/ discipline". The multi-level categories could be agility, obedience, conformation, rally, etc. If a dog has earned 15 levels in agility, this only counts as five towards the 10.

#3 Each title earned must have a certificate and a brief write up on what you did for the prep and what you needed to do to qualify for the title. This should include the amount of time and training involved.

Pictures are always welcome.

Clarification on what an activity, category, and discipline could be. The AMCA's Working Dog (WD) committee currently offers three levels for in each of the four activities. If your dog has all three levels (basic, A and X) for each of the four (pack dog, lead dog, weight pull, team dog), that would be 12 titles. These 12 meet the 10 minimum and would qualify for a BAM as long as the temperament requirement is met.

As with the other AAAM certificates, the BAM can be used in AMCA publications and included in AMCA title holder events. Like the other AAAM certificates, the BAM is not to be listed as a title in AKC catalogues unless it is connected to an AMCA show.

To apply: send \$20 (application fee in US \$) and one copy of each document that shows meeting a qualification to the committee chair. A written statement is needed for the Temperament requirement. There are 4 levels in this program AAAM, VAM, SAM and BAM. We are finding the use of an

email message containing scans of the application works very well. So if you wish to apply for an AAAM, BAM, SAM or a VAM, please >>email<< **your application and snail mail 1 copy with the \$20 application fee if possible**

## **ALL-AROUND ALASKAN MALAMUTE (AAAM) Requirements**

Conformation: A championship title (AKC, CKC, FCI, etc.)

Obedience: A Companion Dog title (equivalent or better, Agility, Rally title)

Sledding: A WTD or a WLD

Weight pull: A WWPD

Backpacking: A WPD

Temperament: This is a BIGGIE! Written verification by a neutral party of what the dog has done in public contact. Neutral party could be a club representative if the program was a local club program... could be a school teacher or principal from a school demonstration...could be an administrator from a nursing home...someone neutral, preferably official.

A Therapy Dog certificate, TT title, CGC title, etc., are not enough to fulfill this requirement, but if the dog has them, including them certainly wouldn't hurt! Hands-on public contact experience is also a major ingredient in this requirement. Be sure to include all examples that apply and at least a rough estimate of the time spent at each. This is important.

Miscellaneous: Optional (or possibly a replace for one of the FIRST five categories). A Tracking Dog certificate, or a verification of work in Herding, Search and Rescue, etc.

**IMPORTANT POINT!** The Temperament requirement of these titles is never to be waived or traded off. It is a definite requirement for the All-Around Alaskan Malamute, the Buddy Alaskan Malamute, the Serviceable Alaskan Malamute and the Versatility Malamute.

## **VERSATILITY ALASKAN MALAMUTE (VAM) Requirements**

For this title, any one of the FIRST five

required categories for AAAM may be dropped in trade for advanced work in TWO of the others... OR...Progress can be shown in one category (ie, a majority of legs in obedience or working, or points in conformation) but not completion, and added to advanced work in another area.

## **SERVICEABLE ALASKAN MALAMUTE (SAM) Requirements**

Conformation: A championship title (AKC, CKC, FCI, etc.)

Obedience: A Companion Dog title (equivalent or better, Agility, Rally title)

Working: Any of the AMCA working titles

Temperament: The same requirements as in AAAM, BAM and VAM

## **BUDDY ALASKAN MALAMUTE (BAM) Requirements**

Any combination of 10 verifiable titles or certificates.

Must be issued by a >>national<< organization like the AKC, AMCA, CKC, UKC, etc. Titles can be ATTS, CGC, Trick Dog, Dock Diving, championship, herding, scent work, tracking, WPD, WWPD, WTD etc.

No MORE than FIVE (5) in any one "activity/category/ discipline". The multi-level categories could be agility, obedience, conformation, rally, etc. If a dog has earned 15 levels in agility, this only counts as 5 towards the 10.

Each title earned must have a certificate and a brief write up on what you did for the prep and what you needed to do to qualify for the title. This should include the amount of time and training involved.

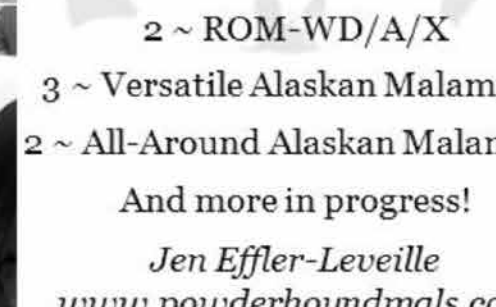

# Why Not try Performance work?

If you haven't explored performance events with your Malamute yet, please consider doing so! There are more options than ever, it's a lot of fun and an outstanding way to increase your bond.

People say Malamutes are "stubborn" and hard to train. I prefer to think of them as independent, self-serving, creative thinkers... but maybe I'm just more stubborn than they are. Seriously, though, I do not find them hard to train. I find them generally bright, quick learners who love being stimulated. It's up to us to find the right methods/style. I often find less is more, meaning if my Malamutes do an exercise perfectly once or twice and I continue to ask them to perform the same exercise, it is likely something will change. Either it will deteriorate or they will try changing something, almost as if they figure it must be wrong if I keep asking them to repeat it. That said, you need to learn how to keep things fun, exciting and rewarding for the dog. A good method should not feel like you are butting heads.

First of all you will want to find an experienced trainer who has lots of experience working with all breeds and enjoys brain-storming when a dog deviates from the norm. You need to have a good sense of humor. If you can't enjoy and appreciate their nature, you probably don't belong owning a Malamute.

One source for finding a trainer, might be to do a search on the Certification Counsel for Professional Dog Trainers website ([www.ccpdt.org](http://www.ccpdt.org)). The Association of Pet Dog Trainers will also list certified and non-certified trainers: ([www.apdt.com](http://www.apdt.com)). If competition is your goal, I would suggest finding someone who also competes, so they understand \*how\* to use treat/rewards without the dog becoming dependent.

Positive reinforcement based training is the only way to go. That's not to say that I am opposed to fair and appropriate correction, especially once the dog understands what is expected and makes a choice not to comply. Correction should not be punitive, it is simply to "make right" and clarify in the dog's mind that the behavior is not optional. Most of the APDT and CCPDT trainers are probably using the LIMA approach: least intrusive minimally aversive.

Avoid group training classes that insist on drilling. You will eventually want the dog comfortable with approximately twice as much heeling as they will be expected to perform in the ring. Build on success. I would not heel the dog for more than a couple minutes on pleasure walks.

While obedience was around long before me, I recently realized I am one of the early competitors in a few other venues. I started agility in 1992, was the local Rally Guru for many years and added Nosework (called Scent Work in AKC) in 2011. Thankfully, when I started training there was already a trend away from compulsion based training and I connected with a mentor who was very much into attending educational training and behavior seminars and trying/implementing new ideas. An ear pinch was still a common method of teaching a formal retrieve in competition circles. It never made sense to me, nor was I emotionally comfortable with the idea of it, so I sought out other options. My first obedience dog was a rescue Golden Retriever, so simply setting the dumbbell in her mouth and back-chaining from there worked well enough. However, I quickly learned this was not the best method for my first Malamute! He taught me shaping the behavior with a marker was the way to go and I've stuck with that method since.

There is nothing in the AKC Rule Book that says dogs must watch you while heeling, but it certainly looks impressive and seems to clarify what is expected. Obedience heeling/position is much more rigid than Rally. You will lose at least one-half point for any/all deviations from perfect heel position: forge, lag, bump, wide. I aim for the dog's ear to be lined up with my left pant seam.

I find rally easier/less stressful because you can talk to the dog as much as you want. However, I think if one does tons of rally, it's easy to mess up your competition obedience precision heeling. Stress is not your friend in the ring. My first Mal saw it as an excuse to ignore me.

It's interesting how one's life changes. I find myself thinking of my grandparents often now! I remember hearing them talk about all the changes in the world over their lifetimes. For example, from horse and carriage to automobiles or from radio to television. While obedience competition was around long before me, I recently realized I am one of the early competitors in a few of the "newer" venues.

So when considering whether to add performance to your Malamute's repertoire, just look at some of the amazing accomplishments we've seen!! Some people will tell you silly things like "Malamutes aren't trainable" or "you can't do that with a Malamute." When you can plainly see some of the amazing accomplishments (OTCH, UD, UDX, MACH, PACH, etc.) others have achieved with their Mals, so I say: "go for it!" Good luck, but most of all have fun and enjoy the journey!
