Hello, all! I'm hoping everyone has been enjoying some companion and performance events with their dogs this summer. I know here in the NY/PA region, we had several malamutes competing at our really well-run AMCA All-Breed Agility Trials. My COBY completed one of his Masters Preferred agility titles at the one in Erie in July. I also just completed a weekend of stewarding in the Utility ring for my local obedience club's annual obedience and rally weekend, and next week I take my youngster out to play in UKI agility. You know how "focused" young malamutes

can be... so in UKI we can enter "Not For Competition" and can take in a toy. I am hopeful this sort of experience and lack of pressure can help naughty girl TEEGA to relocate the brain cells that seem to disappear when she gets into the ring.

I have mentioned elsewhere online, that I recently had the opportunity to put my dog over the new-ish Clip and Go brand agility teeter. I LOVE it! It has gas shocks in the base and pads on the landing edge to absorb the bounce and impact, and the board is much more rigid than wood or plastic filled aluminum, so it does not flex and spring back up under the dog (known as "board whip"). It reminded me of a

dead blow hammer- when it drops it just stays there until the dog leaves it, no rebound. My dog noticed it was different right away and I am pretty sure he liked it. If you have a chance to check one out, I'll be interested to hear what you think. Next up, I want to try out the Clip and Go PADDED A-frame! Just have to find a club that has one...

I do want to assure everyone that with some welcome and capable assistance, we are working on catching up the backlog of certificates and awards for all our hardworking companion event competitors! Some excellent progress is being made and I hope to see the first batch getting into the mail soon.

## Crossing of the Italian Apennines with sled dogs - February 2018

Italy is a nation known throughout the world for its territory rich in natural beauty, for the welcoming people and, last but not least, for its cuisine!

Last winter we had the opportunity to participate with our Alaskan Rock Kennel team, in the Traversata Balla coi Lupi -i.e. Crossing Dancing with Wolves. It is a unique sleddog event that combines the beauties of our country in a mountain territory of great cultural and tourist interest, with a sporting activity with dogs.

A group of passionate volunteers from Miscoso, a small village in the Tuscan-Emilian Apennines, has been organizing this non-competitive event for several years, and invited a select group of mushers participate in the Crossing to discover the wonderful scenery of the Apennine Mountains. This is a five-day crossing, organised into five stages, for a total of about 120 km. In order to promote their area and at the end of each stage, restaurants, hotels and shops offered mushers and handlers gastronomic specialties of the land as well as nights at the hotels. All the lunches and dinners were completely free!

The organization of this trek was impeccable. The organizers constantly ensured the safety of the participants and the wellness of the dogs and opened up the difficult trails each day as there was always a lot of fresh snow..

In this adventure we were accompanied by EVA, the Magician Billie Jean King, MOHS, Mohs Hardness Ten of the Alaska Tundra, JACOB, Jakob Vici Severu and IRA Ira Vom Friauler Zar - white shepherd and, as guest star we had the little mascot GEA, Noatak's Adsila.



In their first experience of stake-out bivouacs, with mushers in near tent, the dogs did not show any discomfort and adapted perfectly to the closeness of the other teams and to the newness of the situation.

The Alaskan malamute displays its sled dog character of traveling long distances by taking advantage of the stops to rest and recover the energies, but they restart promptly and with enthusiasm when requested.



Our choice of using a large wooden toboggan, with only four dogs proved to be correct. Indeed, it is a stable and robust sled suitable for the strength and rythm of our malamutes.



During the days of the trip we did not miss the opportunity to stop and take some nice pictures and to talk with the more experienced mushers.

In the Crossing Balla Coi Lupi we experienced our traditions, new routes for sled dogs and the great spirit of collaboration and solidarity among the mushers.

# Banking your Alaskan malamute's DNA with CHIC

Social media is all a buzz about canine health and DNA testing these days. Responsible breeders are testing their dogs for the tests available for their breeds and making breeding decisions armed with the knowledge the results provide. But, are they banking their dogs' DNA? Unfortunately, many are not.

The Canine Health Information Center, CHIC, maintains a database of health information on dogs. To receive a CHIC number, Alaskan Malamutes must be tested for Hip Dysplasia through OFA or the British Veterinary Association, and have a CERF eye examination. Currently, testing for [Autoimmune Thyroiditis](#) is optional. Each CHIC dog's data is stored in the searchable online public database.

Many people do not know that CHIC also has a DNA Repository Program. The DNA Repository Program stores DNA on submitted dogs and, though it maintains confidentiality from the public, the DNA and data remain available to researchers who request its use in their genetic studies.

Everyone should submit DNA on all their dogs. Obviously, it helps researchers develop tests for our beloved breed, but there are other advantages to submitting DNA. DNA collected now could save a breeding program. Dogs only available for breeding via frozen semen can be tested and utilized. It could also be used to trace the beginning of genetic problems that appear in a bloodline. The possibilities are endless.

Thank you to those who have submitted DNA, but researchers need more samples to start developing DNA tests, now and in the future. Let's take on the mission of collecting DNA on all our dogs and submit it to the CHIC DNA Repository. It's simple and cheap (as little as \$5), so let's make sure the DNA for the next test is already in the database waiting to be found.

To submit your dog's DNA, follow the simple steps below:

1. Go to the CHIC website (<http://www.caninehealthinfo.org/dnabank.html>) and fill out the DNA Application Form and submit to CHIC with the appropriate fee (\$5 for cheek swab, \$20 for blood).
2. Your barcodes, health survey and instructions will arrive in the mail soon or you can fill it out online.
3. Collect the samples and label according to the instructions. (Many Veterinarians will not charge for CHIC blood collections if you ask.)
4. Mail the cheek swabs or blood along with the Health Survey and other required documentation to the appropriate lab. Mouth swabs and blood samples go to different labs.
5. Once processed, CHIC will issue each dog a certificate with a PIN number.
6. If your dog experiences a change in health status, contact CHIC via email of the change so the database can remain current. Reference the PIN number when contacting CHIC about any dog in the repository.

The CHIC DNA Repository is the missing link for making these tests a reality. Together, we can make it happen.

Genetic testing is important for any breed, for the dog's individual health and well-being as well as for any breeding dogs to ensure healthy puppies in future generations. Paw Print Genetics offers genetic testing for three diseases known to occur in the Alaskan Malamute. Testing for these diseases provides you the information that you need to keep your dog healthy and to select appropriate breeding pairs to avoid producing affected puppies.

The first disease is the Alaskan Malamute Polyneuropathy. This disease is an inherited neuromuscular condition that affects dogs between the ages of 3 and 19 months of age. The first signs of this disease may be a change in their bark, noisy breathing, exercise intolerance and loss of hindlimb coordination. The disease is progressive resulting in muscle wasting, abnormal gait or inability to walk. Testing of this disease is required for CHIC and using results in your breeding program can eliminate producing affected pups. This disease is inherited in a recessive manner meaning that two copies of the mutation are required to produce the symptoms of polyneuropathy. Dogs that have one copy of the mutation are carriers and are not affected. Breeding carriers to clear (normal) dogs will result in about 50% of pups being carriers and about 50% being clear. Pups from a carrier x clear breeding should be tested to determine which pups are carriers if those dogs will become breeding dogs.

Alaskan Malamutes are also susceptible to an inherited eye condition called Cone Degeneration. With this condition, dogs that have two copies of the mutation will develop day blindness and photophobia (light sensitivity) between the ages of 8-12 weeks. This degeneration of the cells in the retina, called the cone photoreceptors, will progress over the life of the dog, with adult dogs having complete loss of the cone cells. Although affected dogs will have difficulty seeing during the day, the night vision is not affected, and affected dogs can still see in low light. Testing for Cone Degeneration will provide breeders information about which dogs are carriers and support breeding carriers only to clear dogs. Like with Polyneuropathy, carrier x clear breedings will produce about 50% carrier pups and about 50% clear pups and genetic testing will be needed on the pups to identify the carriers.

The last disease known to Alaskan Malamutes that can be tested with genetics is Degenerative Myelopathy. Degenerative Myelopathy, or DM, is a progressive neuromuscular disease that affects dogs later in life. Known as Lou Gehrig's disease or amyotrophic lateral sclerosis in humans, in dogs DM is inherited as a recessive condition. Dogs with one copy of the mutation in *SOD1* are carriers and dogs with two copies of the mutation in *SOD1* are at-risk for developing

the disease. This genetic condition is known to have incomplete penetrance, meaning that not all at-risk dogs will develop the condition. There are likely genetic modifiers in the genome that may influence the occurrence of this condition in at-risk dogs. Although the chance of getting the condition in at-risk dogs can be variable, because DM can be tested for in dogs, it is prudent to test for this condition and use the genetic information to avoid producing at-risk pups.

Testing your dogs for these genetic conditions will allow you to avoid producing pups with these diseases and help improve the overall health of your breed. This code is valid through December 31, 2018.
